Crimes Involving Drugs and Alcohol 2024 New Hampshire

This theme presents an overview of Crimes Involving Drugs and Alcohol for the selected jurisdiction and year.

Crimes Involving Drugs and Alcohol data is collected in New Hampshire via detailed incident reports using the National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS). These reports are completed after the preliminary investigation of a call for service or complaint.

This theme only accounts for the reports made by Law Enforcement and not the findings of a court, coroner, jury, or prosecutor.

Offenses include Drug/Narcotics Violations, Drug Equipment Violations, Driving Under the Influence, and all offenses where the offender used alcohol or drugs.
