New Hampshire

This theme presents an overview of Violent Crimes for the selected jurisdiction and year.

Violent Crime data is collected in New Hampshire via detailed incident reports using the National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS). These reports are completed after the preliminary investigation of a call for service or complaint.

This theme only accounts for the reports made by Law Enforcement and not the findings of a court, coroner, jury, or prosecutor.

Crimes: 1,561 Clearance Rate: 46.38%

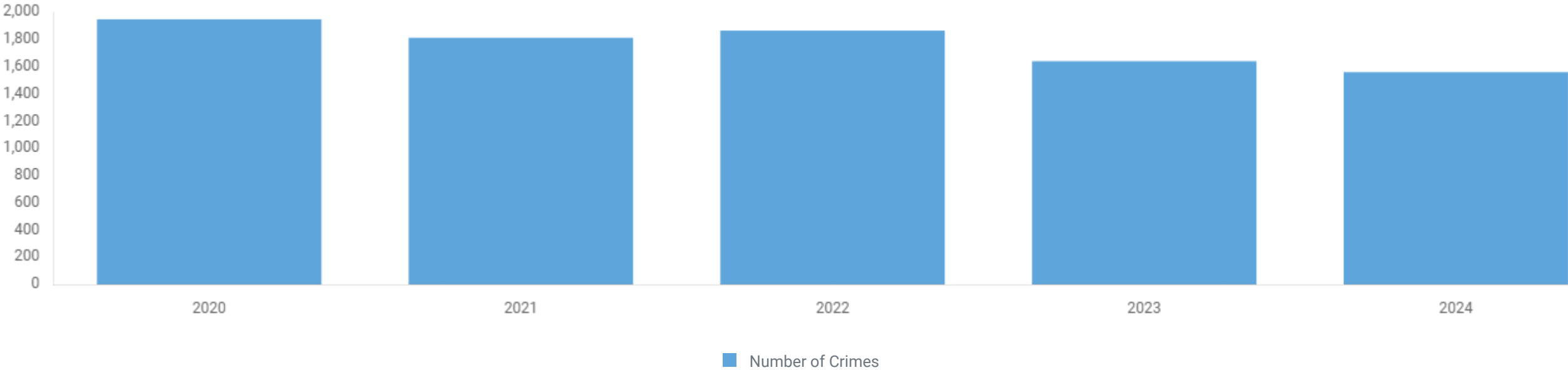

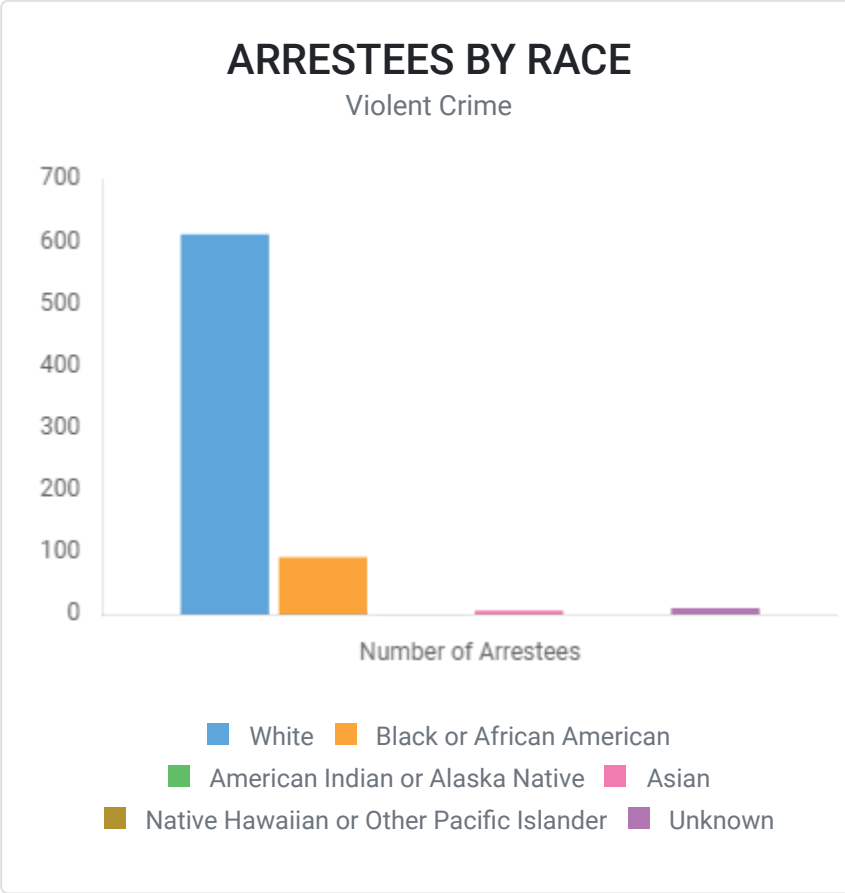
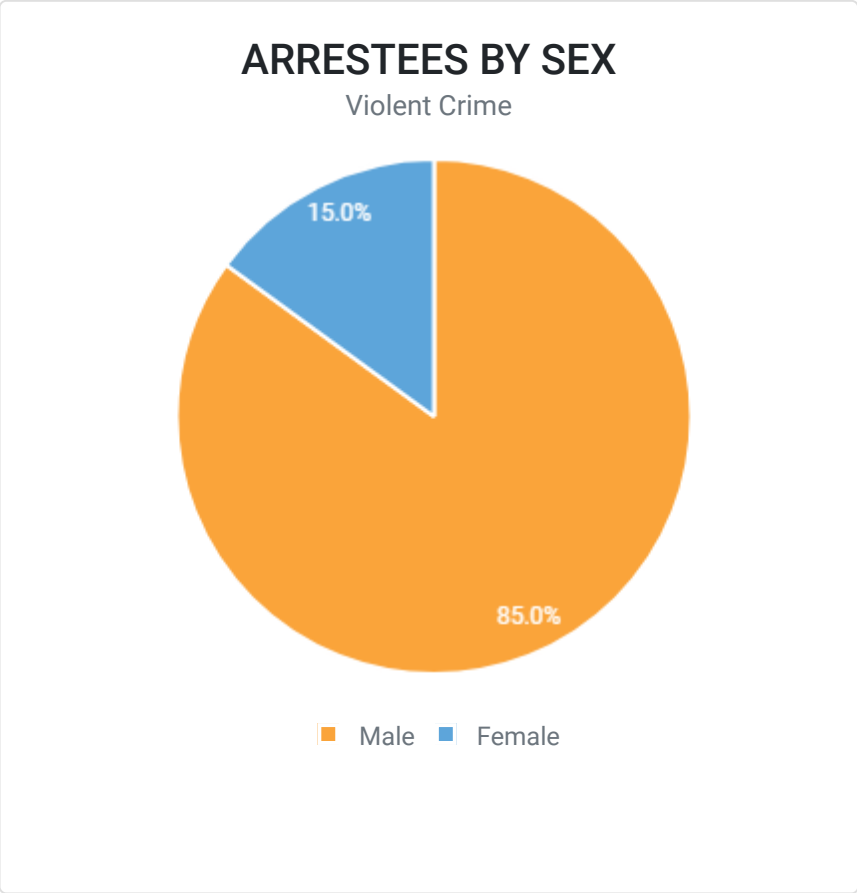
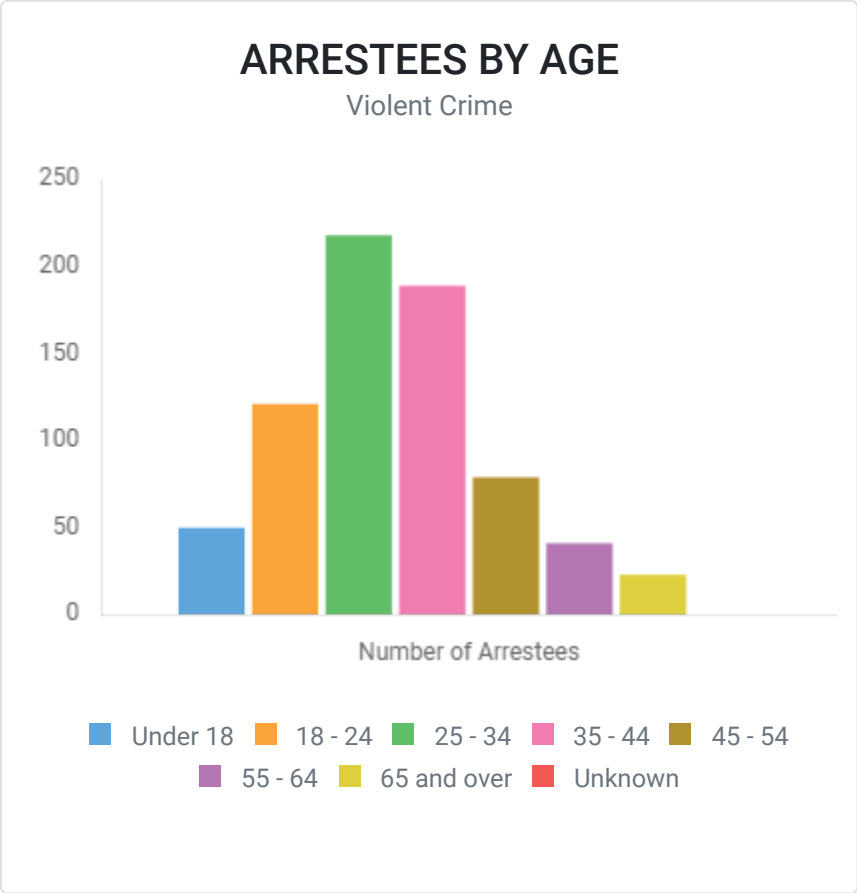
VIOLENT CRIME ARRESTS

The willful (non-negligent) killing of one human being by another.

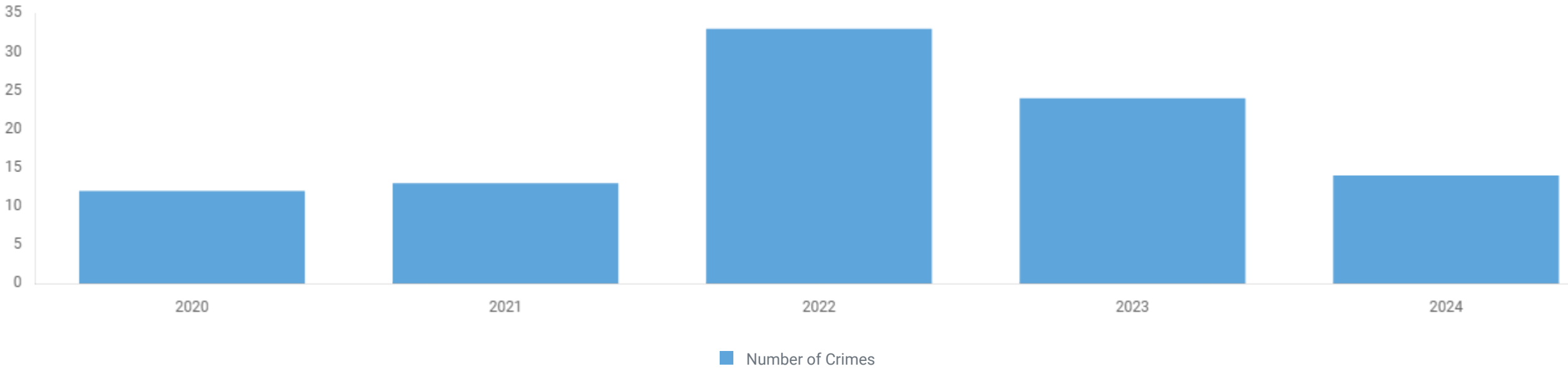

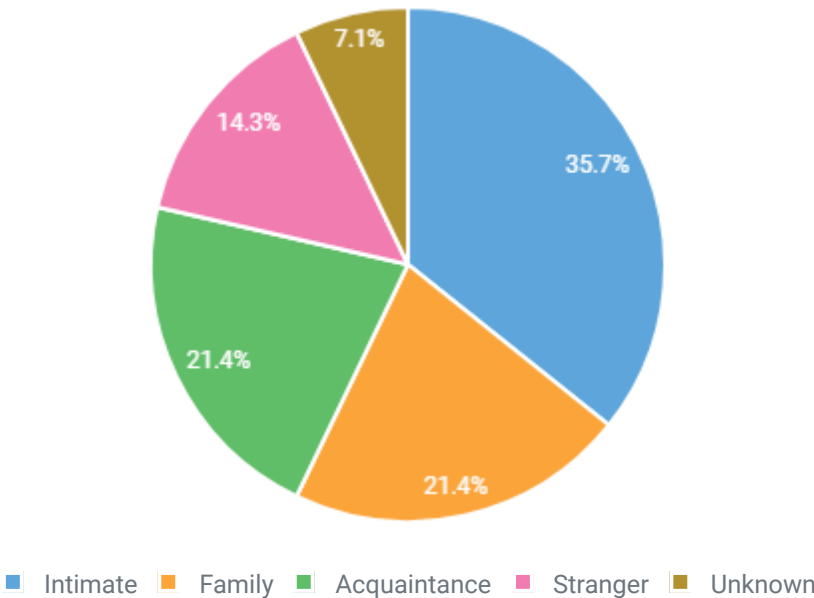

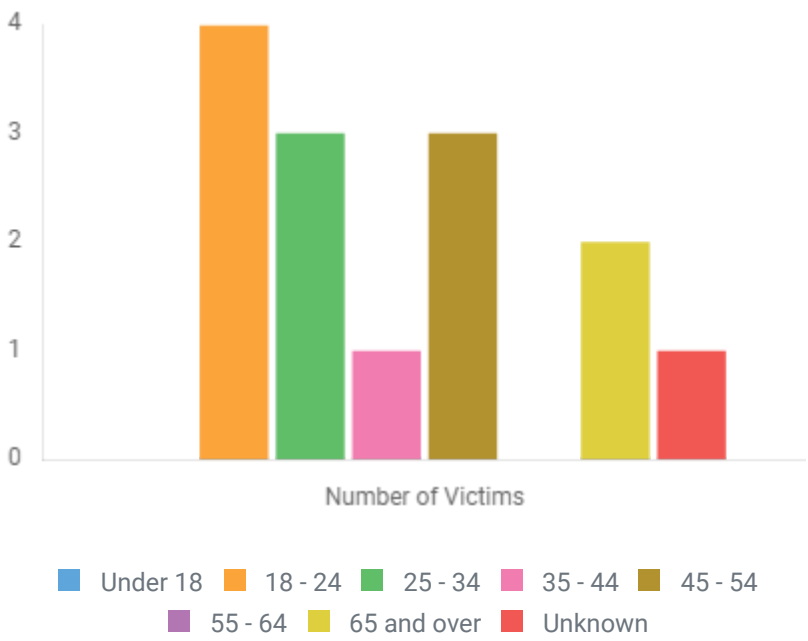
VICTIM TO OFFENDER RELATIONSHIP

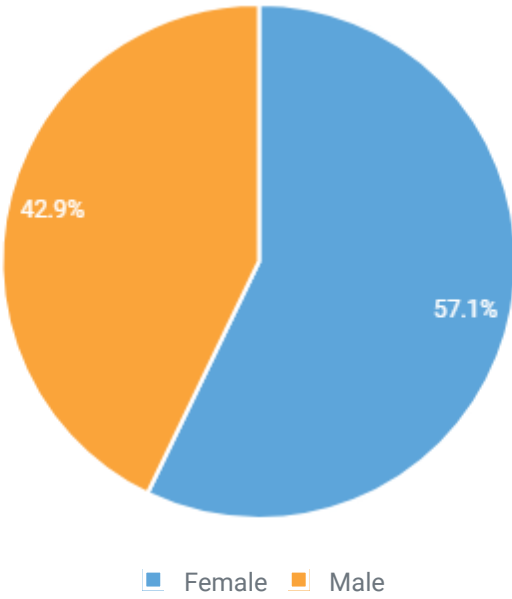
VICTIMS BY AGE

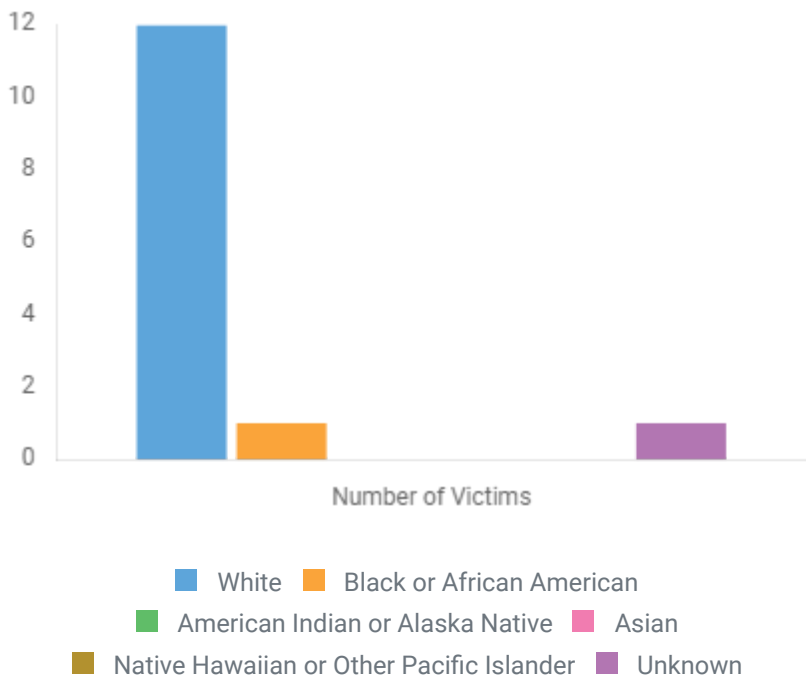
VICTIMS BY SEX

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

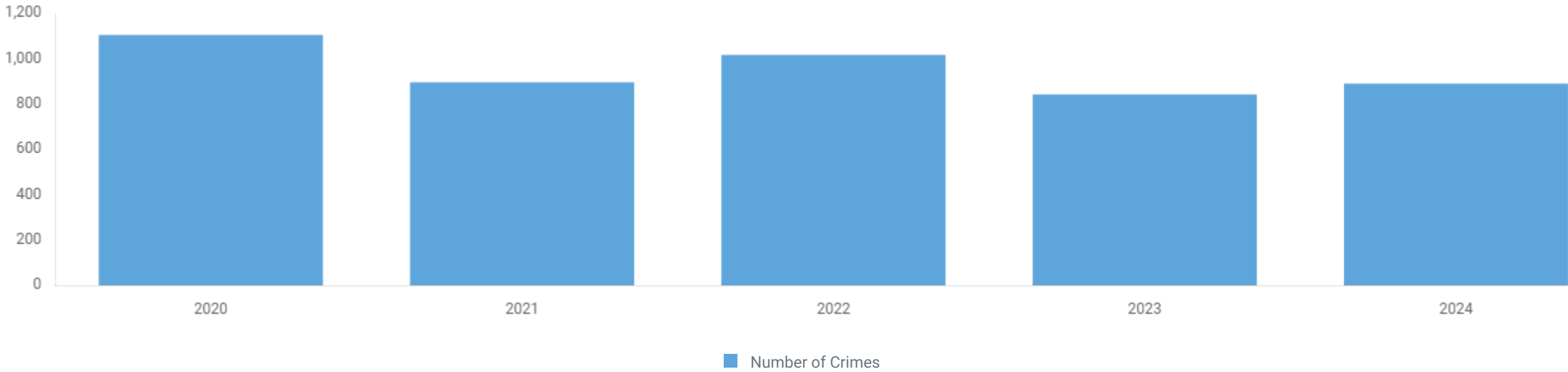
An unlawful attack by one person upon another wherein the offender uses a weapon or displays it in a threatening manner, or the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possible internal injury, severe laceration, or loss of consciousness. This also includes assault with disease (as in cases when the offender is aware that he/she is infected with a deadly disease and deliberately attempts to inflict the disease by biting, spitting, etc.).

Crimes: 891 Clearance Rate: 61.95%

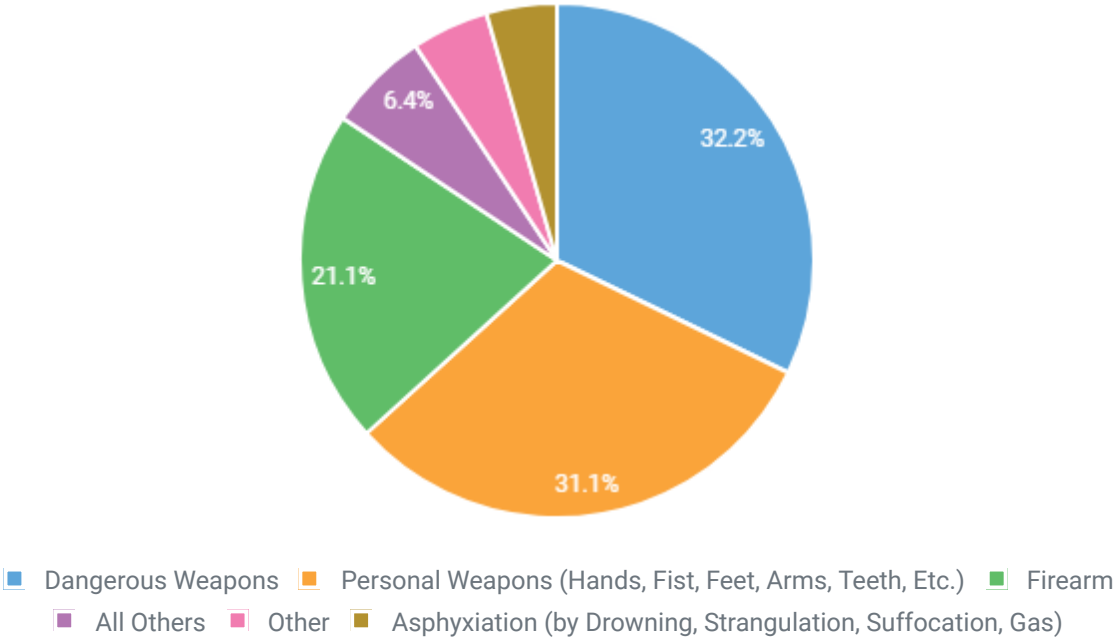

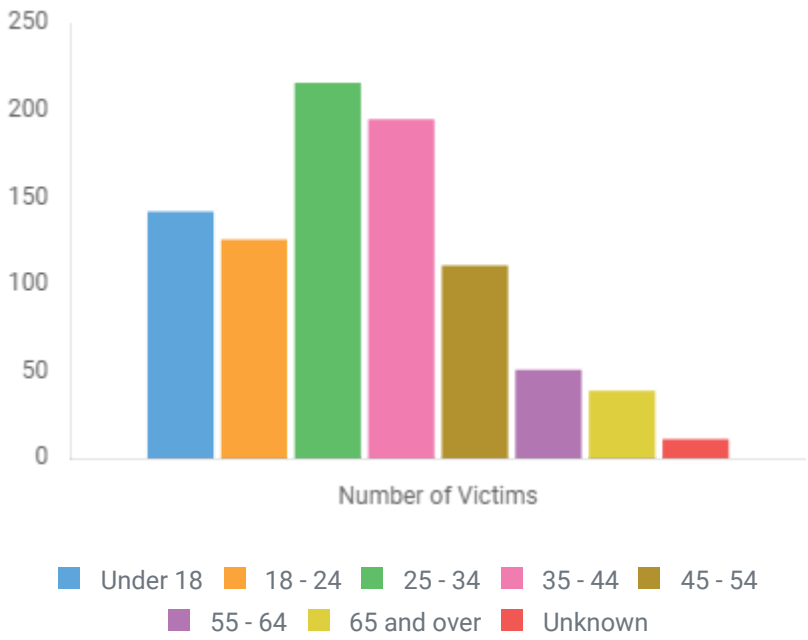

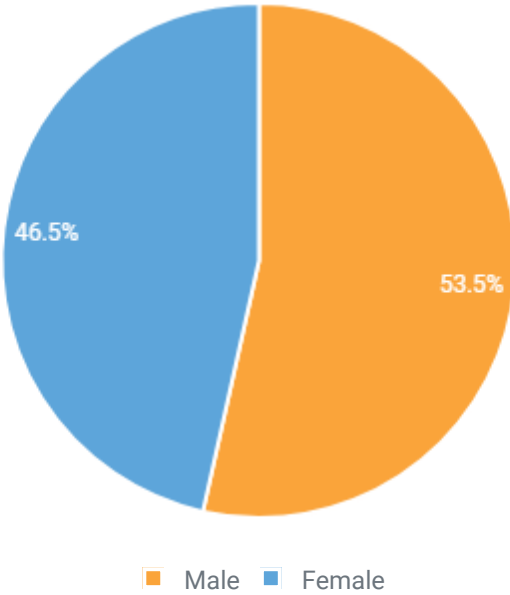

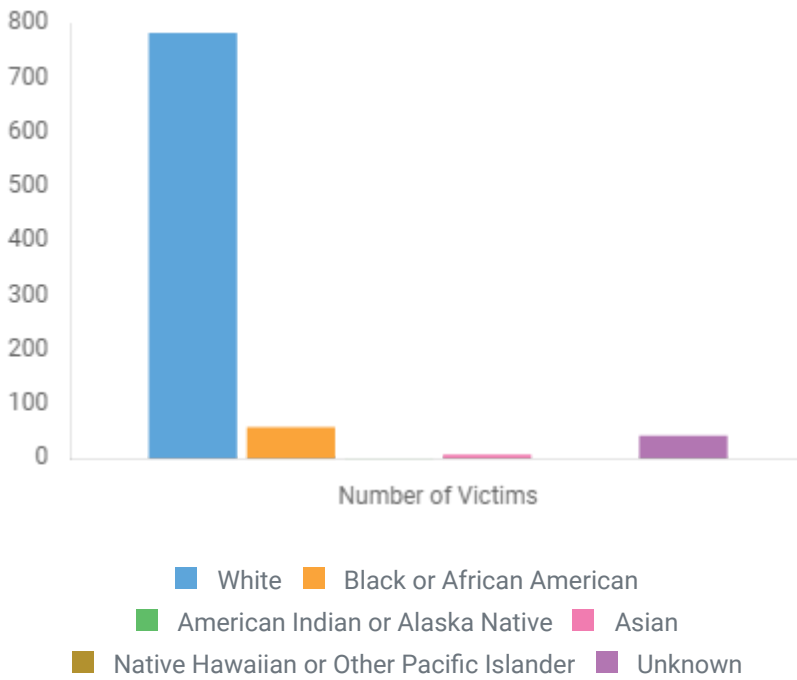
VICTIMS BY AGE

The taking, or attempting to take, anything of value under confrontational circumstances from the control, custody, or care of another person by force or threat of force or violence and/or putting the victim in fear or immediate harm.

Crimes: 180 Clearance Rate: 55.00%

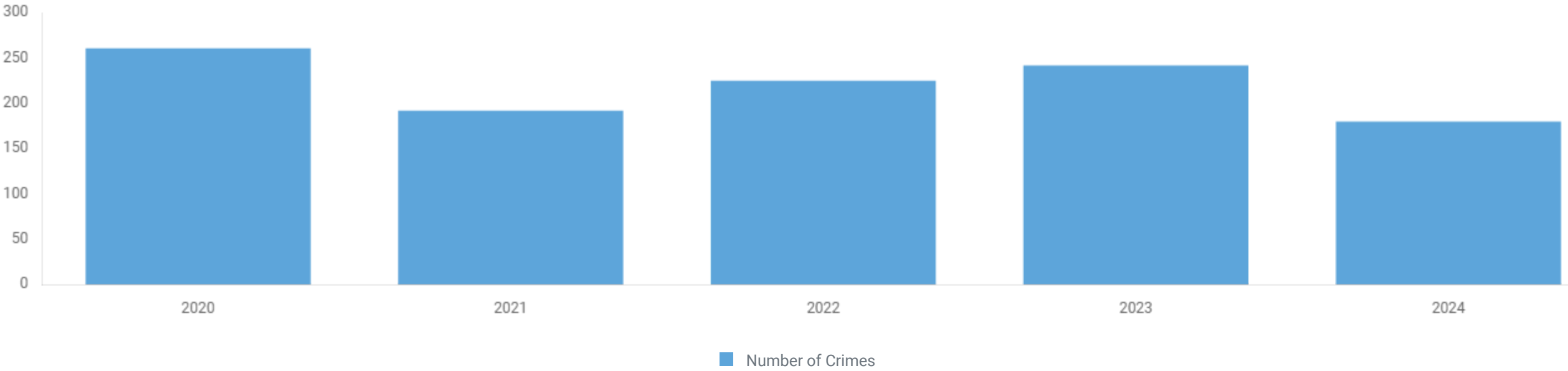

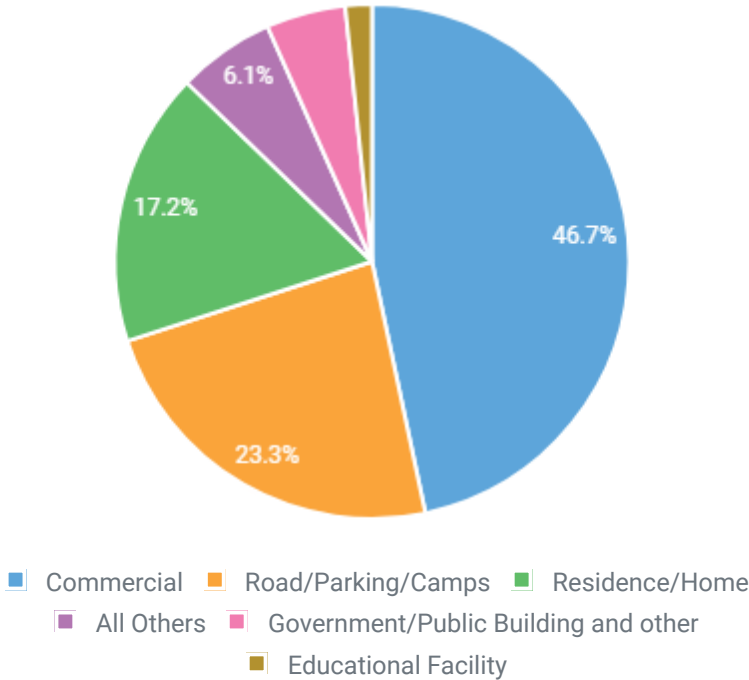

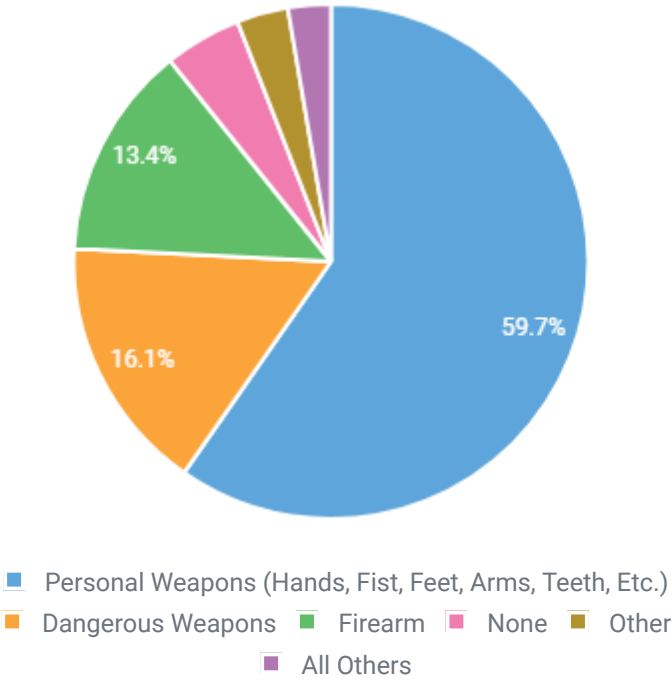
LOCATION

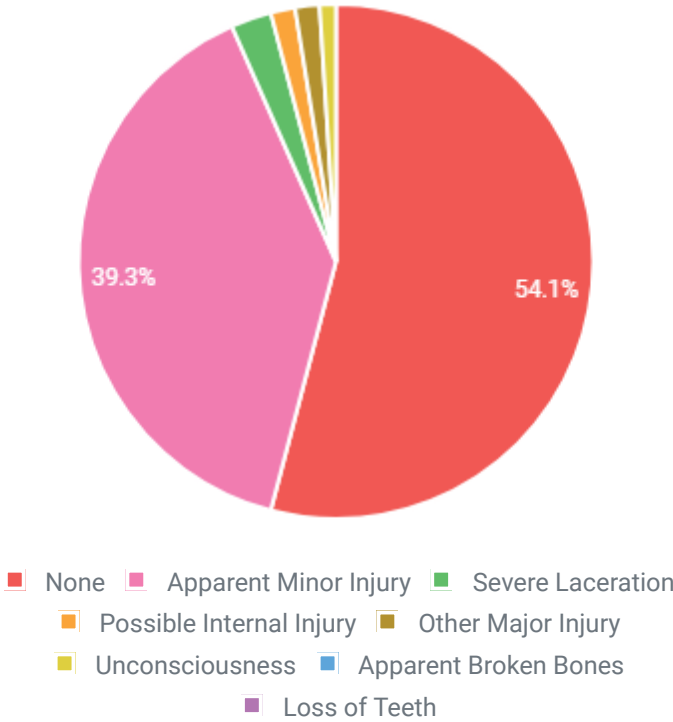
WEAPON TYPE

VIOLENT SEX OFFENSES

Any sexual act directed against another person, without the consent of the victim, including instances where the victim is incapable of giving consent. This only outlines the most violent sexual acts such as Forcible Rape. More data regarding all criminal sexual acts reported in New Hampshire can be found in the Sex Offenses theme.
